Dr. Galarreta-Aima recently published a textbook on Medical Spanish, *Intermediate Medical Spanish: a Healthcare Guide for the Latino Patient*.

Hyoun-A Joo is an assistant professor of German at the School of Modern Languages at Georgia Tech in Atlanta, GA. Her research interests include second language acquisition, sociolinguistics, and intercultural pragmatics at the workplace.
